Week	Topic	Objectives
1	Traditional tales origins	Understand that some stories have been around for many years and the original writer is not always known That many traditional tales have the same beginning
2	Traditional Tales Structure and characters	To understand that traditional tales often follow a theme e.g. a good character, a bad character, something happening followed by the good character winning in the end.
3	Traditional tales Structure, beginnings	To understand that traditional tales have a beginning, middle and end. To find out which part of a story is the beginning
4	Traditional tales Structure, middles	To understand that the middle of the story includes something happening that captures the readers imagination
5	Traditional tales Structure, endings	Finding out about how the tales end. Discussing whether endings are happy or sad Sentences used to end stories
6	Traditional tales Story plan (2 sessions)	To use the ideas heard in traditional tales to plan a story using a story plan To have a go at writing a story using their story plan to support
7	Language development Speaking and listening	To find out about and discuss information and facts
8	Language development Listening and understanding	To understand, discuss and empathise with different situations
9	Language development Sentence formation	To listen to a factual story, to sequence the events and to form a sentence to describe
10	Language development Descriptive words	To think about how to improve sentences by adding interesting and powerful descriptive words
11	Language development Comparing different situations	To use prior knowledge and information to make decisions and share and explain own thoughts and ideas
12	Language development Understanding and speaking	To use prior knowledge to decide and discuss situations being aware that others have different opinions than self
