Week	Topic	Objectives
1	Information books comparing and identifying books	Understand the difference between non-fiction and fiction books. Understand that information books have contents and indexes To be able to identify information books and begin to understand how they can be used to find things out
2	Information books structure of books including headings, photos etc.	To discuss the features of an information book, decide what makes a good book and begin to gather information to create own book, including using a camera to take photos for the book
3	Information books Producing own information book	To work together to create pages of a book including headings, photos, information captions and sentences
4	Information books Producing own information book	To add index and contents to the book and front and back covers to finish the book. To talk about how good the book is.
5	Poems and rhymes	To understand the difference between poems and stories and non-fiction texts
6	Poems and rhymes	To think about how to create a poem using rhyming words and describing words accurately
7	Stories Comparing settings	To find out about how different stories have different settings, some that are real and some that are imaginary
8	Stories Planning a setting for a story	To look at different settings with a similar theme, to compare and then to plan out setting for a story
9	Story Planning the characters	To look at different characters in stories with similar settings and to plan characters for own story
10	Stories Planning the structure	To look at different structures of stories with a similar setting and to plan the structure of own story
11	Stories Writing a story	To use the story plan to write their own story including the chosen setting, characters and structure.
12	Stories Comparing each other's stories	To listen to each other's stories to compare and discuss
